It's Time to Say Goodbye!

After 29 successful years, the **AMIS Plus data collection** will conclude on **31.12.2025**.

We wish to express our sincere appreciation to all AMIS Plus hospital participants and sponsors for your longstanding commitment, trust and invaluable support. Your dedication has shaped the project and made its many achievements possible. Regrettably, the project cannot be continued in this form due to insufficient financial support from industry and government, data-collection methods that are no longer state-of-the-art, and limited resources within participating hospitals.

The **AMIS Plus Data Center** will close on **31.3.2026**.

However, **the database will remain** at the Epidemiology, Biostatistics and Prevention Institute of the University of Zurich, under the responsibility of Prof. Milo Puhon, and will be preserved for future reuse to enable further scientific analyses and publications. **As before, proposals may be submitted to the AMIS Plus Research Committee for approval, following the same process as has been used until now.**
